Lake Pearl is located at 299 Creek Street in Wrentham MA.

Take exit 15 off of I-495 (same exit as the Wrentham Outlet Mall). Go North at the exit onto Rt 1A. Proceed about one mile on Rt 1A and turn left onto to Creek Street. If you get to the center of Wrentham, you went too far. On Creek Street, go about 1/2 mile. Lake Pearl will be on your left. Take the first entrance near the tent. Check in at the registration table and you will be directed to the parking area on the grass.




